

## Important Safety Information

# English

Thank you for purchasing KEF Ci series custom installation loudspeakers. These products have been designed for dry-lined, stud partition walls and ceilings and for suspended ceilings and will deliver many years of superb sound quality. For your own safety, please read the product manual and important safety information before you use the appliance. For any other services, please contact your local authorised KEF distributor, whose details can be found at [www.kef.com](http://www.kef.com).

**Read Instructions** - All the safety and operating instructions should be read before operating the appliance.

**Retain Instructions** - The safety and operating instructions should be retained for future reference.

**Heed Warnings** - All warnings on the appliance and in the operating instructions should be adhered to.

**Follow Instructions** - All operating and use instructions should be followed. Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.

**Installation** - Installation should be performed by an installer who is skilled in the proper use of hand and power tools, knowledge of local building and fire codes, and who is familiar with the environment behind the wall or ceiling where the speaker is being installed. No attempt should be made to install these loudspeakers unless you are sure you will not be cutting through electric cables, water or gas pipes, or supporting joists. Ensure the loading on the wall or ceiling will support the weight of these assemblies. If you have any doubts about the electrical installation of this speaker, consult a qualified electrician.

**Heat** - The appliance should be situated away from heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves or other appliances (including amplifiers) that produce heat. Do not place any naked flames, such as candles, on the appliance.

**Handling** - The appliance should be transported with the cart, stand, tripod, bracket, or table specified by manufacturer, or sold with the apparatus. When a cart is used, pay caution when moving the cart/ appliance combination to avoid injury from tip-over.

**Operation** - Continuous listening to very loud program material via loudspeakers can lead to permanent hearing loss. Prevent damage to your health and avoid continuous listening at high volumes.

**Non-use Periods** - Unplug the appliance during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.

**Cleaning** - The appliance must be disconnected from the power supply or pairing devices before cleaning. Clean with a dry lint free cloth. Do not use any harsh cleaning agents, spirit based cleaners or solvents.

**Damage Requiring Service** - The appliance should be serviced by qualified service personnel when:

- a) The power supply cord or the plug has been damaged; or
- b) Objects have fallen: or
- c) Liquid has been spilled into the appliance; or
- d) The appliance has been exposed to rain; or
- e) The appliance does not appear to operate normally or exhibits a marked change in performance; or
- f) The appliance has been dropped or the enclosure is damaged.

**Servicing** - The user shall not attempt to service the appliance beyond that described in the operating instructions. All other servicing should be referred to qualified service personnel.
